Khwattu, the San Culture and Education Centre, is an 850 ha nature reserve, a place dedicated to the oldest inhabitants of SA, the San or Bushmen.

Darling- Known as the wildflower jewel of the West Coast, presents an annual wildflower. Visit the Renosterveld Reserve behind; Tienie Versveld reserve; Oudepost reserve or Duckitt Orchid Nurseries

West Coast National Park / Potsberg nature reserve. Postberg area is open to the public only during August & September.

Paternoster - Visit Cape Columbine Nature Reserve and well-known Tietiesbaai for beautiful spring flowers. From winter to early summer, be on the lookout for whales & dolphins.

The Khomani San (Bushman) story is a long one that started thousands of years ago when their ancestors still moved freely across Southern Africa, following the rains, the plants and the animals that brought them life.

At the south-western tip of the Park, lies some 28 000 hectares of land, restored to the #Khomani San in the historic settlement of one of democratic South Africa's significant land claims. Together with a similar area granted to the neighbouring Mier Community, the Heritage Park, as it has been named, provides an opportunity for #Khomani San and sensitive visitor alike to immerse themselves in all facets of Kalahari life.

Proclaimed as a Contractual National Park, it enjoys the highest level of statutory protection while conferring certain rights on the #Khomani San - the rights to enjoy the use of the land and its living resources in a manner that contributes to the maintenance of ancient knowledge, culture and practise in a sustainable manner.
